3. Rules & Consent

- The driver must know and follow all regulations, conditions and rules.

4. Briefing

- All drivers must attend a mandatory briefing which takes place in a conference room at the karting track.
- English briefing is from 20:15 until 20:45. Briefing in Czech is from 20:45 until 21:15.

5. Opening ceremony

- Opening ceremony takes place on Saturday morning from 08:00 until 08:15.
- During the opening ceremony there will be a photo session for participating drivers and the championship will be officially started.

6. Starting procedure

- Drivers start their runs according to their racing numbers from 1 to 99.
- The racing numbers are assigned according to the categories, which means that the race cars from the same category always start "together" (see entry list).
- In the Stock and Sport categories, dabblers must take a minimum 10-minute break between runs of a given vehicle and tire warmers are forbidden.

7. Livetiming & Championship standings

- Links for the livetiming, detailed results and championship standings are posted on the website europeanautoslalom.com.
- Livetiming always shows only the current run. The times from previous runs and championship standings are in other documents.
- PC with monitor is ready to freely use for results browsing in the HQ tent.

8. Nations Cup

- All nations automatically participate in the Nations Cup.
- Nations Cup regulations have been adjusted to ensure fairness for countries with fewer drivers. Only the top five drivers in their classes score points for each country in the Nations Cup (see rules).

9. Safety on the track

- Drivers are obliged to observe and obey the signals of the track marshals at all times.
- **Red flag:** Signals that the run stops immediately due to safety or organizational reasons. The driver is obliged to immediately stop and wait for further instructions.

10. Parc-Ferme

- All drivers must park their race cars at the parc-ferme area during the respective times (see timetable).

11. Additional program

- There will be an additional program during the weekend - Simulator contest, PitStop Challenge and Social Media Contest.
- If you want to join some of the contests, check the boxes in the registration document.
- Simulator Contest: It takes place at the paddock during hours mentioned in the timetable. Anyone (not only drivers) can attend the contest. The attendant with the lowest lap time achieved will be the winner of the Simulator Contest.
- PitStop Challenge: It takes place at the paddock during hours mentioned in the timetable. Anyone (not only drivers) can attend the challenge. The attendant with the lowest PitStop time achieved will be the winner of the PitStop Challenge.
- Social Media Contest: There will be a photo gallery posted on the Facebook profile of EASC with posts of all drivers who sent their photos before the championship. The driver with the most likes on his/her photo will be the winner of the Social Media Contest (sharing is allowed).
- Announcement of the winners and trophies will be given during the podium ceremony.

12. Foto & Video

- Photos are secured by Zdenek Vlkovic (IG zvfoto_photography).
- Official large photo gallery will be published on the website and social media.
- If you want some special and individual photos, please contact Zdenek directly.
- Video will be secured by a team of organizers and will be published on Instagram and Facebook throughout the weekend so follow our IG and FB profiles.

13. Track

- Track A is open for trackwalk on Friday from 17:00.
- Track B is open for trackwalk on Saturday evening and Sunday morning (see detailed timetable).
- Drivers can attend trackwalk by foot, on bicycle or scooter (scooters, etc. with petrol engines are forbidden).
- Practice run on Track B is splitted into two days. Stock and Sport Categories run on Saturday evening; Racing categories on Sunday morning. This point may be the subject of the change based on the current time situation (will be specified during the day).

14. Food

- The foodtruck at the paddock operates from Saturday morning until the evening and from Sunday morning until the closing ceremony.
- The restaurant at the main circuit operates every day (including Friday) from 09:00 until 22:00 (<https://slovakiaring.sk/sk/ring-restaurant>).
- All dining facilities accept cash and credit cards.

15. Other regulations

- The organizer reserves the right to change the rules.
- Due to the inability to include all aspects in the rules, the Race Director's decision over-rules this document.
